ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Annual General Meeting of the Club will take place on 28th May 2010 in the dining room.

Notices asking Full Members of the Club in good standing for resolutions and notifying them about the Annual General Meeting have been on display from 1st March 2010. No resolution was received by 31st March 2010 as stipulated in the rules and by-laws of the Club implying that no Full Member wished to have any motion moved at the Annual General Meeting.

Election of Committee Members will take place during the Annual General Meeting. The Committee is made up of nine Full Members who then elect their Chairman and the Vice Chairman among themselves. Three of the Committee Members retire every year by rotation but are free to offer themselves for re-election.
